We will focus on:

- to disseminate the results of the surveys and interviews conducted;
- to familiarize the participants with the key elements that contribute to the successful implementation of the online course;
- to learn about the difficulties and challenges involved in setting up an e-course.

The event is targeted for academic teachers and authorities, and for all interested in remote and hybrid academic teaching.
