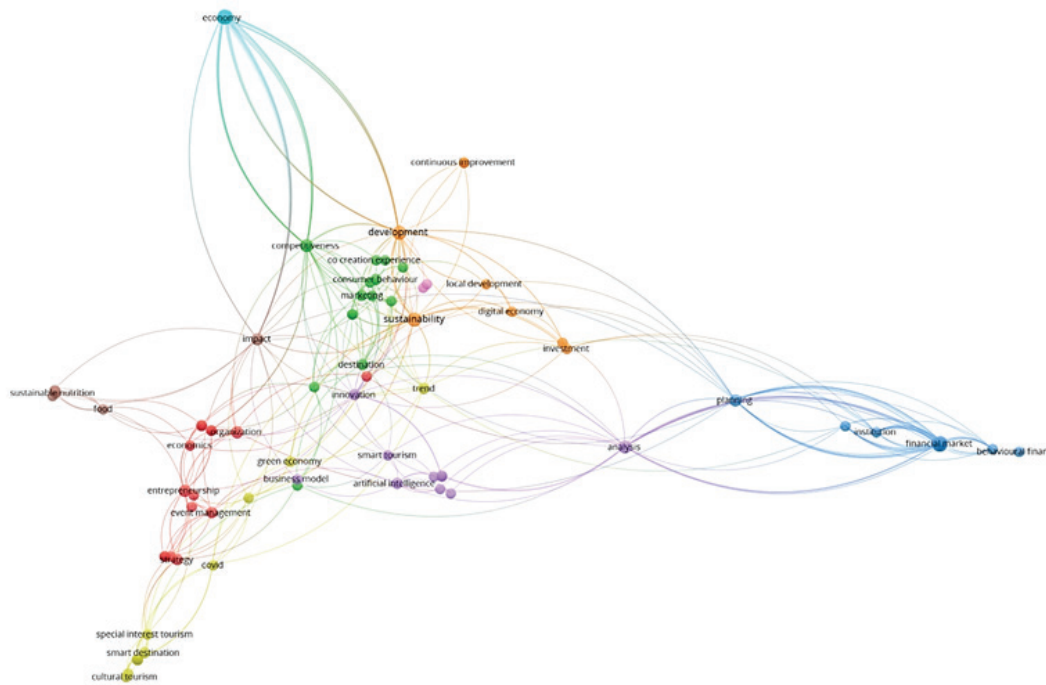

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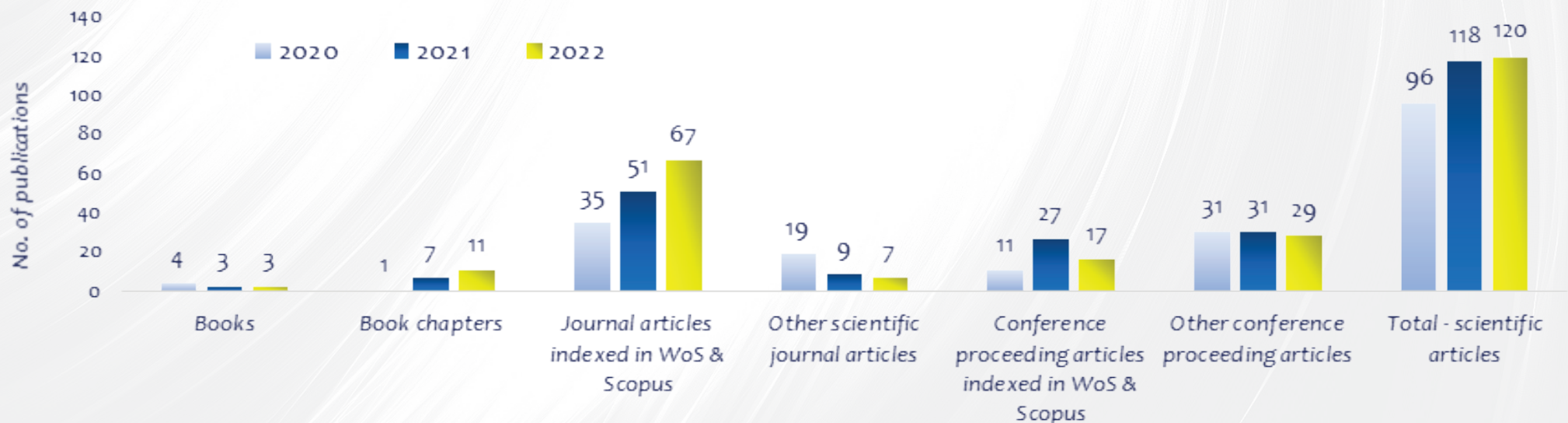
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# INTRODUCTION

The Faculty of Tourism and Hospitality Management (FTHM) places great emphasis on scientific research, especially in the field of tourism, hospitality and sustainable development. The Faculty promotes excellence and conducts all activities in accordance with the principles of ethics and social responsibility.

This document contains an overview of the scientific activities of the Faculty's researchers in 2022. In addition to the research outputs of the seven Faculty Institutes and the profiles of their researchers, information on conferences attended, members of editorial boards and peer reviews is also included. Information about the Faculty's scientific journal: *Tourism and Hospitality Management*, the 26th International Congress: Tourism and Hospitality Industry 2022 - THI 2022, and projects carried out in 2022 are also included.

In 2022, faculty members showed high scientific productivity. In total, the researchers of FTHM published three books, eleven book chapters and one hundred and twenty scientific articles in 2022. Quantitatively, the total number is about the same as in 2021, but more importantly, the quality of publications has increased. In 2022, members of FTHM published 67 articles in WoS/Scopus-indexed journals (an increase of 91% over 2020 and 31% over 2021). In 2022, 19 articles were published in Q1 journals and 7 in journals of excellence (Exc journals).



For the first time, FTTHM became a partner in the HORIZON project (BOLSTER - Bridging Organizations and marginalized communities for Local Sustainability Transitions in Europe) in 2022. In addition, researchers were involved in 33 scientific projects led by members of FTTHM in 2022 (a 57% increase in the number of active scientific projects compared to 2021).

Faculty members have participated in numerous international conferences and authored reviews for high-impact journals. Many faculty researchers are editors or members of editorial boards of international journals.

Faculty researchers explore various research concepts in tourism, hospitality and management as members of seven institutes. Considering the results obtained, the increasing quality of scientific publications and the experience gained, we have no doubt that the future will bring us new experiences, scientific projects, opportunities and partnerships that will produce high-quality scientific results.

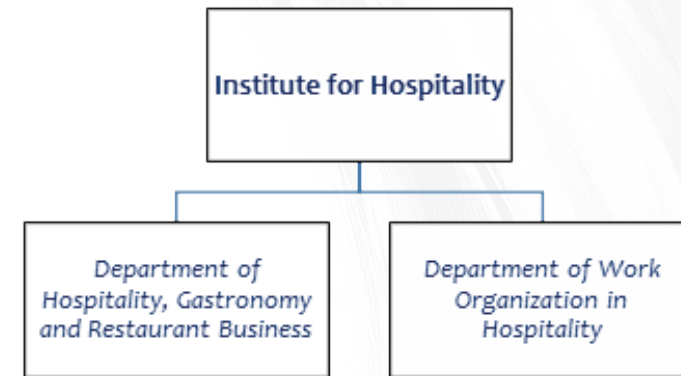
# INSTITUTE FOR HOSPITALITY

**The Institute for Hospitality** focuses on scientific research with the goal of linking its findings to educational materials in the areas of business economics, organization, and management. The members of the Institute of Hospitality focus on the development and application of the latest knowledge on the development of the profession, on the transfer of knowledge to students and professionals. During their studies, students acquire knowledge, skills and competences in the field of hospitality through theoretical and practical teaching.

Members of the Institute actively participate in scientific projects, as project leaders or members of research teams. They present the results of their research at international and national conferences and publish them in scientific journals and conference proceedings. Future research of the Institute members is based on entrepreneurial management in tourism and hospitality, strategic management in hotel companies, economics of hospitality companies, gastronomy and restaurant business management, food and beverage management, standards in hospitality, hotel operations, organization of hospitality services, organizational behaviour, education in tourism and hospitality, CRM, guest experience, guest relations, employee relations, enogastronomy and many other topic related to hospitality and tourism.

Hospitality, Gastronomy and Restaurant Business department combines two important areas:

# INSTITUTE FOR MANAGEMENT

**The Department of Management** is the largest department within the Institute and encompasses a variety of different academic and professional interests, including management in tourism and hospitality, event management, sports management, business models, animation management, stakeholder and community management, camping benchmarking, new technologies, trade diplomacy in tourism and hospitality, etc. Some of the courses offered at various levels of study are: Management, Strategic Management in Tourism and Hospitality, Project Management, EU Project Management, Management of Small and Medium Enterprises, Event Management, Sports Management in Tourism, Management of Cultural and Art Institutions, Project Management in Tourism and Hospitality, Entrepreneurial Management and Innovation, Principles and Practice of the Tourism and Hospitality Industry, Tourism Animation, etc.

The members of the **Department of Quality and Controlling** cover the areas of quality management and corporate management systems (controlling) with their teaching and research activities. The teaching activities enable the acquisition of specific learning outcomes necessary for professional development in the field of corporate control and quality management in profit, public and non-profit companies. Expertise in the area of business economics is developed using specific examples from the tourism, hospitality, and non-profit sectors. In the area of quality management, the main research topics include integrated management systems, business excellence models, continuous improvement processes, Total Quality Management and Corporate Social Responsibility. In the area of management control systems, the focus is on the application in the hotel industry, on KPIs, but

also on the application of management and management control principles in the non-profit sector with a special emphasis on (self-) funding, fundraising and social entrepreneurship. 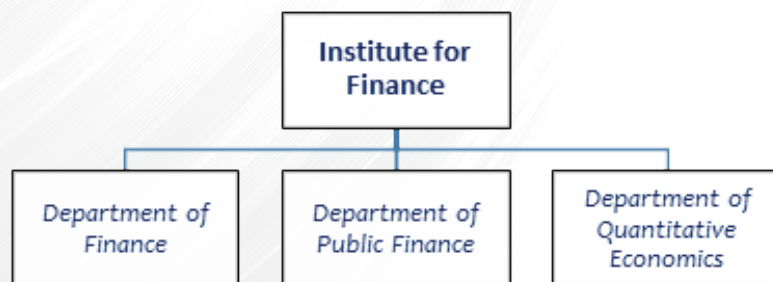

**The Institute for Accounting** has two main objectives. The first is to provide students with a high quality education in various accounting subjects to enable them to pursue their careers in leadership positions in the tourism and hospitality industry. The biennial International Congress “Tourism & Hospitality Industry” (THI) is a multidisciplinary congress that brings together policymakers, industry, and academics since 1972.

The Faculty of Tourism and Hospitality Management hosted the 26th International Congress “Tourism & Hospitality Industry” 2022 on October 21, 2022 together with the first scientific-professional conference *Hotelska kuća*. The event gathered more than 100 participants and was supported by the Association of Employers in the Hotel Industry of Croatia; the National Association of Family and Small Hotels and the Association of Employers in Croatian Hospitality.

The Proceedings of the 26th Congress, “Tourism and Hospitality Industry – Trends and Challenges” includes 24 full papers revised according to the reviewers’ comments.

The Organizing and Program Committee of the first Scientific-Professional Conference *Hotelska kuća* brought together a number of distinguished experts from the hotel industry who delivered plenary lectures. Presentations and discussions during the conference focused in particular on current trends and promotion of excellence in the hotel industry as a prerequisite for competitive and sustainable development of Croatian tourism. The conference proceedings is in Croatian and includes 11 full papers that were successfully presented during the conference. As part of the conference, a workshop for professional practice mentors was held under the title “The role of mentors in professional practice - role model, motivator or more?”, the aim of which was to share knowledge and experience in the field of organization and implementation of professional training of students in the hotel industry.

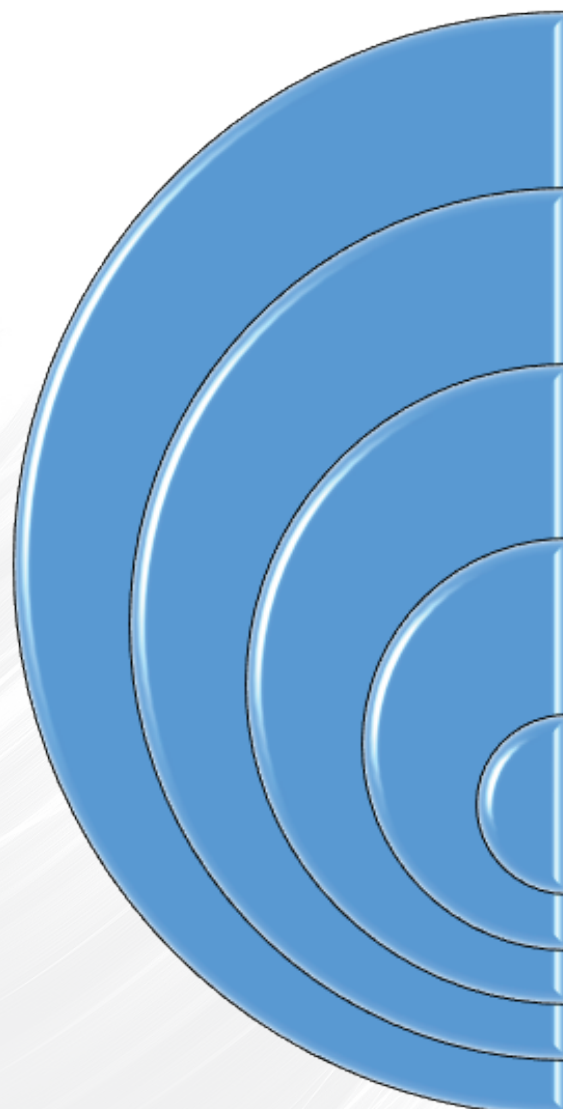
