Pursuant to Article 9, paragraph 1 Statute of the Faculty of the Tourism and Hospitality Management and in accordance with the Decision on tuition fees, student's entitlement to tuition fee subsidies and the conditions and criteria for students' participation in tuition costs in the academic year 2025/2026 (CLASS: 007-01/25-03/02-02; REG.NO: 2170-137-01-25-102, of 14. April 2025), Decision on the amount of enrolment fees and the designated allocation of the fund in the academic year 2025/2026 (CLASS: 007-01/25-03-02; REG.NO: 2170-137-01-25-103, of 14. April 2025), the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Tourism and Hospitality Management, in its 31<sup>st</sup> session held on 5 June 2025, has adopted the following

**DECISION**  
**on tuition fees in the academic year 2025/2026.**

**GENERAL PROVISIONS**

I.

This Decision establishes the amount of tuition fees for the university undergraduate program in Business Economics in Tourism and Hospitality, the university undergraduate program in Business Economics in Tourism and Hospitality – Management in Hospitality, the English-language module, the university undergraduate program in Sustainable Development Management, the university graduate programs in Marketing in Tourism, Management in Tourism, Management in Hospitality, Sustainable Tourism Development (online study), Management in Tourism at SC Zabok, the students' right to subsidise tuition fees and the conditions and criteria for student participation in tuition fees for the academic year 2025/2026.

The terms used in this Decision that have a gender form, apply equally to all persons.

**TUITION FEES**

II.

The amount of tuition fee for the academic year 2025/2026 are determined as follows:

1.	Full-time students:	950,00 €	1 ECTS = 15,83 €
2.	Part-time students (Croatian and EU citizens):	950,00 €	
3.	Part-time students enrolled in SC Zabok (Croatian and EU citizens).	950,00 €	
4.	Full-time and part-time students (non-EU citizens):	2.500,00 €	
5.	Full-time students (Croatian and EU citizens): – Hospitality Management, module in English, to be enrolled for the first time in the academic years 2024/2025 and 2025/2026:	2.000,00 €	
6.	Full-time students (non-EU citizens): – Hospitality Management, module taught in English, enrolled for the first time in the 2024/2025 and 2025/2026 academic years:	3.000,00 €	
7.	Full-time students – Hospitality Management, module taught in English, enrolled in the 2023/2024 academic year:	1.300,68 €	

## AMOUNT OF THE ENROLLMENT FEES

### III.

The enrollment fees for the academic year 2025/2026 are determined as follows:

- First enrollment in the first year of study is € 55.50
- Enrollment in a higher year of study or re-enrollment in the same year is €40.00

The enrollment fee is charged to students upon their first enrollment in the first year of study, in a higher year, and for re-enrollment in the same year.

The obligation to pay the enrollment fee does not apply to:

I. Students who lived in the areas affected by the earthquake on 29 December 2020 and had their place of residence in Sisak-Moslavina County, with buildings classified as N1/N2 or PN1/PN2 (usable) based on a preliminary damage assessment by a certified structural engineer in accordance with the methodology of the Croatian Centre for Earthquake Engineering (supported by a current proof, e. g. a certificate from the Civil Protection Headquarters);

II. students from Ukraine who have been granted temporary protection in accordance with the decision of the Government of the Republic of Croatia of 7 March 2022 and its extension of 27 February 2025.

## RIGHT TO TUITION FEE SUBSIDY FROM THE STATE BUDGET

### IV.

The right to a full subsidy of tuition fees from the state budget is granted to Croatian citizens by the Regulation on Programme-based Financing of Public Universities and Public Higher Education Institutions

Programme-oriented Financing of Public Universities and Public Scientific Institutes in the Republic of Croatia (OG 78/2023) as follows:

- I. Croatian citizens and citizens of other EU Member States enrolling for the first time for the first academic year in 2025/2026,
- II. students in higher years who have earned at least 55 ECTS credits in the previous academic year (2024/2025), or at least 30 ECTS credits in the case of students with a disability confirmed as 60% physical impairment or third degree functional impairment,
- III. students who change their degree programme for the first time in the academic year 2025/2026, provided that they have not yet obtained a degree at the same level of study and have previously obtained 55 ECTS or 30 ECTS in the case of students with a physical impairment of at least 60% or a third degree functional impairment,
- IV. members of the Croatian national minority and the Croatian diaspora within the framework of the Cooperation Agreement between the State Central Office for Croats Abroad and the University of Rijeka (signed on 6 May 2019) and the approval of the Ministry of Science and Education of 28 February 2024,
- V. students who are granted temporary protection for displaced persons from Ukraine in accordance with the government decision of 7 March 2022 and its extension of 27 February 2025,
- VI. citizens of the Republic of North Macedonia on the basis of the Cooperation Programme signed between the Ministries of Education and Science of both countries (29 August 2024).

Tuition fee grants are awarded to students with full-time status until they have obtained a degree at each of the first two levels of higher education.

The grant covers the number of years corresponding to the prescribed period of study within a time frame that is twice as long as the standard period of study (e. g. 4 years for a four-year degree programme, 1 year for a Master's degree)

## **PARTICIPATION OF FULL-TIME STUDENTS IN TUITION COSTS**

### **V.**

- Full-time students who have earned fewer than 55 but more than 30 ECTS credits in the previous academic year 2024/2025 must pay a tuition fee for the new courses taken, which is proportional to the number of ECTS credits and is calculated according to the monetary value per ECTS credit.
- Students with full-time status who have earned 30 or fewer ECTS credits in the previous academic year must pay the full tuition fee
- Full-time students who have not achieved the total number of ECTS credits required for graduation within four years in the undergraduate programme and one year in the postgraduate programme, even though they have made use of the right to subsidised tuition fees from the state budget (four times in the undergraduate programme and once in the postgraduate programme), must pay a fee in the following academic year. This fee corresponds to the product of the ECTS credits enrolled and the monetary value of one ECTS credit.
- Full-time students (Croatian citizens, citizens of other EU Member States and foreign citizens from non-EU countries) enrolled in the English-language Bachelor's programme " Business Economics in Tourism and Hospitality – Hospitality Management" and for whom the fee is not covered by funds from the state budget of the Republic of Croatia must pay the full amount of the fee referred to in point II of this Decision.

### **VI.**

A full-time student has the right to repeat each academic year a maximum of once. A student who has lost his/her full-time status because he/she has exercised his/her right to repeat an academic year may continue his/her studies part-time until the deadline specified in point VII of this Decision.

## **TUITION FEES FOR PART-TIME STUDENTS AND STUDENTS STUDYING IN PROGRAMMES TAUGHT IN A FOREIGN LANGUAGE**

### **VII.**

Part-time students and students enrolled in foreign language programmes must pay the full amount of the fee specified in point II of this Decision.

## **FINAL PROVISIONS**

### **VIII.**

A student must complete his/her studies at the latest within a period that is twice as long as the duration of the study programme, as follows:

- In the undergraduate program, within 8 years.
- In the graduate program, within 2 years.
- In the joint professional graduate program, within 4 years.

### **IX.**

The provisions of the Decision of the Senate of the University of Rijeka on the amount of tuition fees, the rights of students to tuition fee subsidies and the conditions and criteria for student participation in tuition costs for the academic year 2025/2026 (CLASS: 007-01/25-03/02-02; REGISTRATION NUMBER: 2170-137-01-25-102) of 14 April 2025 apply accordingly to the realisation of the right to a subsidy for tuition costs borne by the Faculty.

A student has the right to a refund of the tuition fee or part of the tuition fee for the current academic year if he/she has paid a higher tuition fee than specified in this Decision.

Before you enrol for the next academic year, all debts must be paid in full and proof of payment must be provided. Students who do not pay their tuition fees will not be able to enrol for the following academic year.

### **X.**

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption and shall apply from the academic year 2025/2026.
